Canoe/Kayak Storage Application

“A-Frame” and other “storage areas” rules and regulations.
Application for kayaks, canoes, and dinghy storage at the park.

(applications will be accepted no earlier than April 5th, 2010)

Agreement:

Applicant hereby makes application for using the “A-Frame and other Storage Areas” at the rates as listed below. Applicant agrees to hold harmless, the Lake Tahoe Park Association, its members, directors, and employees from any claims whatsoever for any loss or damage arising from the use of the “A-Frame and other Storage Areas” or other facilities in connection with this agreement. Applicant further agrees to lease a space as is, in its present condition, and to have, at applicant’s own expense, general liability and property insurance for use on Association property; that the signing of said agreement, applicant shall be responsible for any claims of liability arising from applicant and/or applicant’s guest, renters, permissive users, or anyone using said “A-Frame and other storage areas” with applicant’s permission, express or implied. Further, applicant agrees to hold harmless Lake Tahoe Park Association, its members, directors and/or employees from all liability and further facilities. Applicant expressly agrees not to assign or sublet their space in the “A-Frame and other storage Areas” and acknowledges such action will result in the termination of this agreement and loss of any fees or deposit.

We hope the following rules and regulations (Do’s and Don’ts) will allow everyone to enjoy the convenience of storing your Kayak, Canoe or Dinghy down near the beach launching area.

Do's:

- 1.. Each storage bay must have a completed application and fees paid, *before* putting item in storage.
2. Each item must have your ownership identity clearly visible inside the craft.
3. *You* are responsible for the security of your craft. Cable locks are preferred.
4. Please coordinate with LTPA staff to be sure your records, space assignment, and compliance with all rules and regulations are complete.

Don'ts:

1. Please do not place items that are *not* a physical part of the craft in or about your assigned space.
2. Please do not impede other craft owners from getting to their craft.
3. Please do not store “blow up” toys and or craft in the area. (a separate bin is now in place for those type of items)
4. Please do not leave litter and/or garbage in the area. There is a dumpster and / or garbage can close by for this use.
5. Do not allow other than properly registered craft to use your space.

Thank you for your cooperation in keeping this area a great place to serve your recreational needs.

Unfortunately we must also put everyone on notice that any violation of these rules could jeopardize your current and future use of these facilities and possibly facilitate the following action.

If the violation persists, we will be forced to cut the locks and/ or cable off any offending craft and place that craft in the Placer County Sheriff's impound yard. This would be a last resort but one we would need to use to keep the integrity and quality of our storage area.

"A-Frames and other storage areas" fees are \$75.00 for entire season or on a weekly basis at a rate of \$10.00 per week.

"First day" for the use of the "A-frames and other storage areas" is **May 17th, 2010**.

"Last day" for the use of the "A-frames and other storage areas" is no later than **November 1st** of each year or sooner if the weather dictates removal.
